

July 2020 Notice to 5G Small Wireless Applicants *(Updated July 13, 2021)*

Subject: Availability of County-owned Streetlight Poles in Pentagon City/Crystal City/Potomac Yard

Arlington's Department of Environmental Services staff has conducted a review of existing and proposed public and private infrastructure work impacting the public right-of-way in Pentagon City, Crystal City and Potomac Yard.

There is currently widespread construction activity in the right-of-way in all three neighborhoods and more County-funded and developer-funded street and utility work that is anticipated through the fall.

Given these conditions, the County originally enacted a temporary pause in the acceptance and processing of small wireless attachment applications for County-owned streetlight poles in the above-referenced areas through the end of calendar year 2020.

**Staff recently revisited this decision and after careful consideration, has extended the temporary pause until Sept. 1, 2021.** As such, no applications for County-owned light poles in this area will be processed during this extended period.
